Courses Offered:

The college offers courses in CIVIL Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical & Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Computer Science and Engineering.

- ➤ We could able to place 85% of the eligible students through campus interviews in leading organizations like TCS, INFOSYS, IBM, Wipro, Tech Mahindra, Hexaware, CAPGEMINI, NTT DATA, HCL, VIRTUSA, SYNTEL etc., with a salary package ranging from Rs.4 lakhs to 10 lakhs per annum. - ➤ All department associations in our college encourage our students by conducting various programs to gain knowledge, skills, and experience in leadership, communication, problem-solving, group development and management, presentation, and public speaking.
- ➤ We are actively conducting programs of "Institution Innovation Council".
- > Our faculty and students actively engaged in publications in journals and conferences.
- ➤ All the cells & committees like women empowerment, women protection, NSS, EDP, R&D, innovation etc. organizing several programs to improve the individual & leadership abilities of students and make them to success in their future career.
- > We celebrated all important international days, national days and festivals to create awareness on global perspectives, culture and individual responsibility

- The central library of SISTK has an OPAC aided Extravagant Digital Library outfitted with abundant Digital books and e-journals. The Library also holds a rich collection of books and journals amounting to 26000 volumes, which cover a broad range of subjects including the humanities, social sciences, management, but mainly focuses on science, and engineering and technology. The library has a comprehensive operating system with a variety of sources: students may find information through the online database and the network resources. The library also has a large collection of CDS, Audio and Video tapes on technical and general subjects to improve the teaching learning process. You can also search for e-journals using our Digital Library.
- The Central Library has also subscribed to e-resources of IEEE / IEL through INDEST-AICTE Consortium. Through this subscription the institute can access Online 950,000 documents from over 12,000 publications, includes 120 journals (International), transactions, magazines, conference proceedings, IEEE standards. This covers almost one third of the world's current electrical engineering and computer science literature.
- > The college has conducted 9 professional development / administrative training programmes organized by the Institution for its teaching and non-teaching staff during the year.
- ➤ In the academic year 2020-21, Teachers are provided with financial support in 32 activities to attend Conferences/workshops and towards membership fee of professional bodies.
